

Waste paper Recycling Plant Inaugurated at CMPDI



A waste paper recycling plant, **first of its kind in Jharkhand** was inaugurated at CMPDI campus on 24th March'2014 by CMD, CMPDI, Shri A.K.Debnath. On this occasion, he emphasised that it reflects CMPDI's commitment towards sustainability as well as environmental protection by utilising the waste paper generated in the office. This plant has the capacity to recycle 1 tonne of waste paper per month. The recycled paper produced in-house will be utilised for making company's letter heads, visiting cards, envelopes, files, folders, etc. This initiative shall reduce our carbon footprint as 1 tonne of paper requires cutting of 17 mature trees and about 10 litres of water is needed to produce one A-4 size paper.
